#### **LEARN TO SWIM & SQUADS PROGRAMS**

We have exciting news for our Learn to Swim and Squads program!

From 2025, our Pre-school aged levels Turtles, Seahorse and Sea Otter will changed to Guppy (Beginner), Cuttlefish (Intermediate) and Flounder (Advanced).

In line with Royal Life Saving Australia, our NEW Preschool criteria will focus on developing key swimming and safety skills, which increases student's mobility and independence, thus lowering the risk of drowning and keeping children safer in and around the water.

Squads Program from 2025 will have a new timetable to provide greater flexibility to our Squad families!

This includes new criteria to provide clear goals for our students and extended sessions for our Senior Squads to provide an enhanced progression experience.

Supervision is key to safety, especially for our youngest visitors. That's why we follow the Royal Life Saving Keep Watch Policy:

- 0-5 years: Always keep little ones within arm's reach.
- 6-11 years: Stay close by with eyes on them at all times and be ready to hop in the water at a moment's notice.
- 12-15 years: Maintain constant supervision even the big kids need a watchful eye.
